In this lesson you will learn how to create a simple spoken advert for a toy.

Opinions

In French we can create simple opinions by using “C’est” (it is) and an appropriate adjective. Here are some simple opinions that you can use for this lesson:

C’est magnifique *It’s gorgeous*

C’est fantastique *It’s fantastic*

C’est génial *It’s brilliant*

C’est super *It’s great*

C’est hyper-cool *It’s really cool*

C’est nul *It’s rubbish*

Maintenant, à toi. Ecoutez, répétez.

C’est magnifique (pause) C’est magnifique (pause)

C’est fantastique (pause) C’est fantastique (pause)

C’est génial (pause) C’est génial (pause)

C’est super (pause) C’est super (pause)

C’est hyper-cool (pause) C’est hyper-cool (pause)

C’est nul (pause) C’est nul (pause)

Many of these opinion adjectives are colloquial. There are others that you could use as well like “C’est sensass” (it’s stunning), “C’est chouette” (it’s great) or “C’est extra” (it’s great). Sometimes two or more of these are combined, like in “C’est super-extra-méga-cool”!

Now you can combine a toy, a price and an opinion to make a simple advert. Here are some examples:

La poupée, trente Euros, c'est fantastique !

Le ballon, dix Euros, c'est génial !

La console, vingt-huit Euros, c'est super !
