

NOTES FOR THE TEACHER:

Students use the writing frame to write simple two-word nonsense sentences about what the animals are doing.

Encourage them to use nunc (now), semper (always) and subitō (suddenly) as well as ēheu! (oh dear!) and euge! (hooray!) to enrich their sentences.

A new animal and a new verb have been included in the writing frame:

leo lion

dormit is sleeping

Example sentences:

nunc equus scribit. Now the horse is writing.

ēheu! vēspa semper purgat. Oh dear! The wasp is always cleaning.
